Family Update

Like I said it's been a busy summer for us! The kids finished school well and are looking forward to returning in the fall. We are excited by this because it was a tough transition for them into the Dutch school system. Finnley is enjoying lots of free time to play with his friends, listen to music and is excited to play voetball (soccer) in the fall! Alea is loving all the time with her little sister, playing outside and she is so proud she learned how to ride her bike. Still, with every visitor that comes to our house she is giving riding demonstrations up and down our street. Ava continues to be our little baby even though she is clearly not a baby anymore. Her favourite things to do right now are playing with her brother and sister and trying to help momma with every task possible. Monica and I are enjoying our busy summer. We have both finished our language courses and now have a 3 week break before diving back in again. We still hope to enjoy more time at the beach, picnics and bike rides with the kids before school starts in September.

Ministry Update:

We are continuing our involvement with Kracht om te Veranderen. This involves promotion for the website as well as street evangelism. A short-term youth team from the USA came at the end of July to join in the street evangelism. It was

exciting to see and hear the stories of how God used them in their time here! Hundreds of people were able to hear the gospel and a small number gave their lives to Jesus! We have another team coming August 19-26th. Please pray for this team and for us as we help lead them. They will be on the streets in Alkmaar talking to people about Jesus. Pray that God opens people's hearts and that the team will have the courage to speak truth and freedom into the Dutch people's lives!

Financial Update:

Thank you so much all those who have given towards our ministry here and God's work in the Netherlands! We are so blessed by all our supporters. We have come to realize that we are not adequately funded to continue our ministry here long term. With the continuing rising cost of fuel (we pay \$3 CAD/L!) and with fall and winter around the corner utilities are expected go up dramatically again. These are costs we did not anticipate, therefore our goal is to fundraise an additional \$1000 per month. Please pray with us that God will move in peoples hearts to see His vision here in North Holland. God has been so faithful in providing for us during our time here and we fully trust Him to provide the means to keep us here.
