We had a team from Washington State serve with us from Aug 19th to the 26th. It was so exciting to watch how God used them to reach the Dutch people! We spent the week doing street evangelism in and around Alkmaar. Many good conversations were had and God opened many people's hearts to hear the Gospel! We will be back on the streets with the Kracht om te Verenderen evangelism group this coming Saturday.

I have taken a missionary position at Tyndale Theological Seminary as Project Manager. The facility is in desperate need of major upgrading and renovations. I will be overseeing and assisting with the work being done. We believe this fits in well with our mission here in the Netherlands. Tyndale Seminary houses and teaches pastors and church leaders from all over the world and these students go back into their communities and further discipling and spreading Christ's church globally. I will be serving at Tyndale 3 days during the week and the rest of my time is focused on our ministry here in Alkmaar.

Monica continues to do an amazing job meeting and connecting with people in our community. She was able to help organize a woman's day of prayer for one of the local churches. This was a great success as 20 women came for the day to enjoy fellowship and alone time in prayer. We are excited as God continues to use us and expand our ministry here in North Holland!
